

OPTION B 2 (Hybrid) with these changes: All of middle Erda students currently attending Overlake remain at Overlake. East Erda students currently attending Copper Canyon Elementary will attend Rose Springs Elementary (about 81 students). Students in the DLI program at Middle Canyon will be moved to Copper Canyon.

Option B2: Benson Grist Mill area, Lakepoint, Millpond, Soelberg's area, and Reflections (Crystal Bay Drive) will attend Old Mill Elementary.

Students currently riding a bus from Delgada, Schooner Lane, Fireside Lane, Bayshore Drive, Spring Street, and Elizabeth Street will be bussed to Old Mill Elementary. (Currently attending Copper Canyon Elementary and Rose Springs Elementary)

Students currently bussed to Stansbury Elementary School west of Parkview and north of Christopher Street to Village Blvd. will be bussed to Stansbury Park Elementary.

Students currently attending Overlake from Erda between Bates Canyon Road (including Perry Homes subdivision) and 2400 North remain at Overlake. About 102 students.

Current students within walking distance of Rose Springs Elementary, Stansbury Park Elementary, and Overlake Elementary will continue attending those schools.

The Spanish DLI program will be moved to Copper Canyon Elementary (previous option B). The students behind WalMart will remain at Copper Canyon Elementary.

East Erda students currently being bussed and attending Copper Canyon Elementary will attend Rose Springs Elementary.

Old Mill Elementary

Capacity: 850

Option B2 description:

Benson Grist Mill Area, Delgada, Lower Delgada, Lakepoint, Millpond, Reflections/Crystal Bay, and Soelberg's areas attend Old Mill Elementary.

Future enrollment for option B: Approximately 526 students

Stansbury Park Elementary

Current enrollment 742 – capacity 775

Option B2 description:

Lake point students will attend Old Mill Elementary.

Students west of Park View and between Christopher Street to Village Blvd. currently attending Stansbury Park Elementary will continue to be transported by bus.

Future enrollment for option B: Approximately 650 students

Rose Springs Elementary

Current enrollment 603 – capacity 650

Option B2 description:

Students from Millpond would attend Old Mill Elementary. Students from Soelberg's area would attend Old Mill Elementary. Students from Delgada and Lower Delgada would attend Old Mill Elementary. Reflections/Crystal Bay would attend Old Mill Elementary. Students are currently being bussed to Rose Springs Elementary.

Students in Erda between Highway 36 to 1200 West and between 2400 North to Bates Canyon Road would move from Overlake would remain at Overlake. Approximately 102 students. (Includes Perry Homes) (This is a change)

East Erda students currently attending Copper Canyon between Highway 36 to the mountain and then south to Brooksville Avenue. Includes 2 students across from Rose Springs, north of Bates Canyon. About 81 students. (This is a change)

Future enrollment for option B2: Approximately 510 students

Overlake Elementary

Current enrollment 585 – capacity 650

Option B2 description: Remains as current boundaries.

All of Erda students currently attending Overlake, and located between Highway 36 and 1200 West and 2400 North to Bates Canyon Road would remain in Overlake boundary area. Approximately 102 students. (Includes Perry Homes)

Future enrollment for option B2: Approximately 585 students

Criteria for evaluation of boundary options:

1. Capacity of the school - relieve current overcrowding
2. Neighborhood proximity of schools

Option B Hybrid: Move the Spanish DLI program to Copper Canyon.

Change the boundary of students living behind Walmart that are currently being bussed to Copper Canyon to Middle Canyon boundaries.

Middle Canyon Elementary

Current Enrollment 679 – capacity 675/700

Option B description:

Move the DLI program to Copper Canyon Elementary school next year. The current program has approximately 170 students, with approximately half of those students 90 coming from Middle Canyon Elementary. (Three teachers would be relocated to Copper Canyon along with the students.) Siblings of DLI students may also be attending Middle Canyon Elementary.

~~Students behind Walmart in the apartments/condos currently bussed to Copper Canyon would be bussed to Middle Canyon. (These students currently feed into CJJHS). Approximately 77 students reside there while only about 55 students attend Copper Canyon.~~

Future enrollment for Option B: approximately 509

Copper Canyon Elementary

Current enrollment: 659 – capacity 650/675

Students currently attending Copper Canyon from Benson Gristmill area and Delgada will return to Stansbury Park.

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~~Students behind Walmart in the apartments currently bussed to Copper Canyon would remain at Copper Canyon. (These students currently feed into CJJHS). (This is a change)~~

~~East Erda students currently attending Copper Canyon between Highway 36 to the mountain and then south to Brooksville Avenue. Includes 2 students across from Rose Springs, north of Bates Canyon. About 81 students total. (This is a change)~~

Future enrollment for option B: 547 plus a possible 30 students for DLI program each of the next 3 years. Could be up to 637 at end of 6th grade ~~if 30 students were added each year.~~ Additional growth is predicted in the Copper Canyon boundary.

Criteria for evaluation of boundary options:

1. Capacity of the school - relieve current overcrowding and plan for future growth.
Yes, immediate change. Unknown future growth in Copper Canyon boundaries.
2. Neighborhood proximity of schools
Students remain walking distance. Some dual immersion students from Middle Canyon boundaries will travel further distances.

3. Transitions – Minimize future transitions for students
