

Option A: Students currently riding a bus from Delgada, Schooner Lane, Fireside Lane, Bayshore Drive, Spring Street, and Elizabeth Street will be bussed to Rose Springs Elementary. Students in Perry Homes on Bates Canyon Road remain at Overlake with the option of attending Rose Springs through the open enrollment procedures.

Students currently bussed to Stansbury Elementary School west of Parkview and north of Christopher Street to Village Blvd. will be bussed to Stansbury Park Elementary.

Benson Grist Mill area, Lakepoint, Millpond, Soelberg's area, and Reflections (Crystal Bay Drive) will attend Old Mill Elementary.

Current students within walking distance of Rose Springs and Stansbury Park Elementary will continue attending those schools.

Old Mill Elementary

Capacity: 850

Option A description:

Benson Grist Mill Area, Lakepoint, Millpond, Reflections (Crystal Bay Drive) and Soelberg's areas.

Future enrollment for option A: Approximately 425 students

Stansbury Park Elementary

Current enrollment 742 – capacity 775

Option A description:

Lake point students will attend Old Mill Elementary. Students west of Park View and between Christopher Street to Village Blvd. currently attending Stansbury Park Elementary will continue.

Future enrollment for option A: Approximately 651 students

Rose Springs Elementary

Current enrollment 603 – capacity 650

Option A description:

Current students from Soelberg's area, Reflections (Crystal Bay), Millpond would be moved to Old Mill Elementary boundaries.

Students from Delgada (currently attending Copper Canyon) and lower Delgada (to the rear of the houses on Elizabeth Street) would attend Rose Springs Elementary.

Future enrollment for option A: Approximately 526 students

Overlake Elementary

Current enrollment 585 – capacity 650

Option A description: Overlake boundary has no changes

Future enrollment for option A: Approximately 600 students

Criteria for evaluation of boundary options:

1. Capacity of the school - relieve current overcrowding and plan for future growth.
Does not balance schools. Old Mill has low enrollment numbers.
2. Neighborhood proximity of schools

OPTION B 2 with all of middle Erda students currently attending Overlake attending Rose Springs

Option B: Benson Grist Mill area, Lakepoint, Millpond, Soelberg's area, and Reflections (Crystal Bay Drive) will attend Old Mill Elementary.

Students currently riding a bus from Delgada, Schooner Lane, Fireside Lane, Bayshore Drive, Spring Street, and Elizabeth Street will be bussed to Old Mill Elementary. (Currently attending Copper Canyon Elementary and Rose Springs Elementary)

Students currently bussed to Stansbury Elementary School west of Parkview and north of Christopher Street to Village Blvd. will be bussed to Stansbury Park Elementary.

Students currently attending Overlake from Erda between Bates Canyon Road (including Perry Homes subdivision) and 2400 North are moved to Rose Springs Boundary. About 102 students.

Current students within walking distance of Rose Springs Elementary, Stansbury Park Elementary, and Overlake Elementary will continue attending those schools.

Old Mill Elementary

Capacity: 850

Option B2 description:

Benson Grist Mill Area, Delgada, Lower Delgada, Lakepoint, Millpond, Reflections/Crystal Bay, and Soelberg's areas attend Old Mill Elementary.

Future enrollment for option B: Approximately 526 students

Stansbury Park Elementary

Current enrollment 742 – capacity 775

Option B2 description:

Lake point students will attend Old Mill Elementary.

Students west of Park View and between Christopher Street to Village Blvd. currently attending Stansbury Park Elementary will continue to be transported by bus.

Future enrollment for option B: Approximately 650 students

Rose Springs Elementary

Current enrollment 603 – capacity 650

Option B2 description:

Students from Millpond would attend Old Mill Elementary. Students from Soelberg's area would attend Old Mill Elementary. Students from Delgada and Lower Delgada would attend Old Mill Elementary. Reflections/Crystal Bay would attend Old Mill Elementary. Students are currently being bussed to Rose Springs Elementary.

Students in Erda between Highway 36 to 1200 West and between 2400 North to Bates Canyon Road would move from Overlake to Rose Springs boundary area. Approximately 102 students. (Includes Perry Homes)

Future enrollment for option B2: Approximately 528 students

Overlake Elementary

Current enrollment 585 – capacity 650

Option B2 description:

All of Erda students currently attending Overlake, and located between Highway 36 and 1200 West and 2400 North to Bates Canyon Road would move to Rose Springs boundary area. Approximately 102 students. (Includes Perry Homes)

Future enrollment for option B2: Approximately 498 students

Criteria for evaluation of boundary options:

1. Capacity of the school - relieve current overcrowding and plan for future growth.
Old Mill is okay, Rose Springs is okay, Stansbury Park is okay, Overlake is low,
2. Neighborhood proximity of schools

3. Transitions – Minimize future transitions for students
Future is unknown with new charter school
4. Safety of students: Transportation and safe walking paths

Option C: Benson Grist Mill area, Lakepoint, Millpond, Soelberg's area, and Reflections (Crystal Bay Drive) will attend Old Mill Elementary.

Students currently riding a bus from Delgada, Schooner Lane, Fireside Lane, Bayshore Drive, Spring Street, and Elizabeth Street will be bussed to Old Mill Elementary. (Currently attending Copper Canyon Elementary and Rose Springs Elementary)

Students currently bussed to Stansbury Elementary School west of Parkview and north of Christopher Street to Village Blvd. will be bussed to Rose Springs Elementary.

Current students within walking distance of Rose Springs Elementary, Stansbury Park Elementary, and Overlake Elementary will continue attending those schools.

Old Mill Elementary

Capacity: 850

Option C description:

Benson Grist Mill area, Delgada, Lower Delgada, Lakepoint, Millpond, Reflections/Crystal Bay, and Soelberg's areas attend Old Mill Elementary.

Future enrollment for option C: Approximately 525 students – 62% capacity

Stansbury Park Elementary

Current enrollment 742 – Capacity 775

Option C description:

Lake point students will attend Old Mill Elementary.

Students west of Park View and between Christopher Street to Village Blvd. currently attending Stansbury Park Elementary will be transported by bus to Rose Springs Elementary.

Future enrollment for option C: Approximately 574 students – 75% capacity

Rose Springs Elementary

Current enrollment 603 – Capacity 650

Option C description:

Students from Millpond would attend Old Mill Elementary. Students from Soelberg's area would attend Old Mill Elementary. Students from Delgada and lower Delgada would attend Old Mill Elementary. Reflections/Crystal Bay would attend Old Mill Elementary. Students are currently being bussed to Rose Springs Elementary.

Students west of Park View and between Christopher Street to Village Blvd. currently attending Stansbury Park Elementary will be transported by bus to Rose Springs Elementary.

Students from Perry Homes Subdivision would have the option to apply for Out of Boundary for Rose Springs Elementary. No transportation provided.

Future enrollment for option C: Approximately 497 + 30 new DLI students = 527 students 81% capacity

Overlake Elementary

Current enrollment 585 – capacity 650

Option C description:

Erda students located between Highway 36 and 1200 West and between Bates Canyon Road and Overlake would remain at Overlake Elementary (Includes Perry Homes). Approximately 102 students.

Future enrollment for option C: Approximately 600 students 92% capacity.

Criteria for evaluation of boundary options:

1. Capacity of the school – relieve current overcrowding and plan for future growth.
Balanced enrollment
2. Neighborhood proximity to schools
Yes. Only students currently riding buses changed boundaries. All walking students remain at current schools.
No. Students riding buses on east end by new charter school has students going to different schools.
3. Transitions – Minimize future transitions for students.
